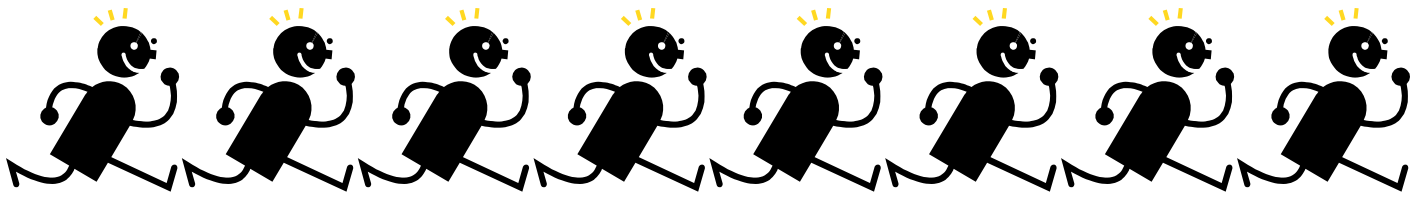

Kenrose Elementary Spring Run Club

Beginning Wednesday, **February 20th**, Run Club will meet every Wednesday morning from 7:40 to 8:15 am at the track. Run club will run through **April 24th**. **We will NOT meet if it is raining (track is wet and not safe) or if the weather falls below 32 degrees.**

Everyone is welcome to join us, from Kindergarten, to parents and staff!! You don't have to run; you are welcome to walk too!! We will ask walkers to stay on outside track and runners on inside for safety purposes.

Six laps around the track is equivalent to one mile. Students 1st thru 5th can count this time on their mileage markers. **All** students that sign up and attend at least 6 of the 9 weeks will receive a 26.2 toe token in honor of the Kids Rock Nashville Marathon on Sunday, April 28th! **You do not have to sign up for the marathon to participate in run club.**

Ideally, students log 25.2 miles before the marathon leaving the last mile to run on race day. Logging and tracking miles this year will be the honor system. ***Logs will be provided for those students that would like to keep track of their own miles.***

Our focus is to build up students endurance to complete the ONE mile on race day (*if they are signed up for the marathon*).

To participate in run club, students must return the form below with a parent signature. There is also a place to indicate if parents would like to volunteer with run club.

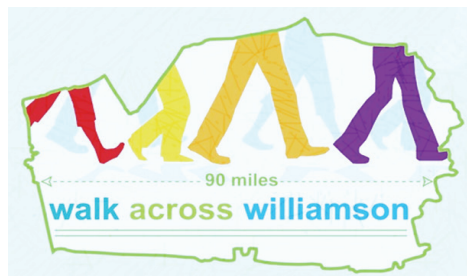

2013 Walk Across Williamson Contest Rules



**LET'S GET PHYSICAL AND WIN SOME PRIZE MONEY FOR THE
KENROSE ELEMENTARY PHYSICAL EDUCATION DEPARTMENT!!!**

We need everyone to participate!! The contest is based on total exercise/activity minutes that participating members accumulate in the month of March. Participating members may be students, school personnel, and family and community members. There is no limit to the number of members that may serve on a school team.

The goal is to be active 1,800 minutes during the month of March. Each team member should record the number of minutes of physical activity on the Activity Log Sheet. Physical activity may include, but is not limited to, time spent in physical education (PE) class, afterschool activities, organized sports teams, active free play, individual activity/sports lessons (e.g. dance; gymnastics), workouts in the gym, walking, and yard work.

The kick-off to the contest will be held at Woodland Middle School on Saturday, March 2nd from 9am-10am. Please look for **Ms. Rhinehart (Double Dose PE teacher)** and wear **your Kenrose apparel**. Make sure you sign in! Also, stay for a group picture at 10am! Come out and walk your dog, ride your bike or just play to earn **60 BONUS minutes!!**

An event to celebrate the completion of Walk Across Williamson is scheduled **Saturday, April 13th** from 9:00-11:00 a.m. at Pinkerton Park in Franklin. Based on the number of minutes logged throughout the month of March, adult and child participants will be placed in one of three prize categories (**must be present to win**):

Instructions for using the activity log

Each day, record the number of minutes you are physically active. Physical activity may include, but is not limited to, time at PE, sports teams or individual lessons, gym workouts and/or walking.

1,800 minutes of physical activity during the month of March is equivalent to walking across Williamson County.

At the end of the month, calculate the **total** number of minutes you were physically active.

Students, parents, and teachers should submit completed logs by **Friday, April 5th** to the designated teacher at your school.
