# Kindergarten Registration 2013-14

We are excited to register our Kenrose kindergarten students for the 2013-14 school year! Kindergarten registration at Kenrose will be held on Wednesday, April 3rd, from 9 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and Thursday, April 4th, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Following is a list of the items that are required for kindergarten registration in Williamson County Schools.

- Minimum of TWO utility bills (gas, electric, or water for last month prior to enrolling), and
- Photo I.D. (driver's license or passport).
- TENNESSEE CERTIFICATE OF IMMUNIZATION & HEALTH RECORD completed and signed by physician
- PHYSICAL EXAMINATION - Must be within a year of entrance to kindergarten, so on or after August 9, 2012.
- BIRTH CERTIFICATE (CERTIFIED COPY)
- **IF APPLICABLE**, COURT ORDERED PARENTING PLAN INDICATING PRIMARY RESIDENTIAL PARENT. PARENTING PLAN MUST BE SIGNED BY COURT OFFICIAL AND ALL PARTIES INVOLVED.

**PLEASE BRING ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS; COPIES WILL BE MADE AT TIME OF REGISTRATION.**

**ENROLLMENT IS NOT CONFIRMED UNTIL ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS ARE RECEIVED. CHILDREN MAY NOT ATTEND SCHOOL UNTIL ALL DOCUMENTS ARE RECEIVED AND CONFIRMED.**

Join us this summer as Kenrose presents another summer of fun. On June 10-14 and June 17-21. ## **High Tech Treasure Hunting**

Treasure hunting has now gone digital in the form of Geocaching! Your child can engage in this rewarding activity as an individual or as a part of a team. Students will problem solving skills and knowledge of geography while partaking in physical exercise. Activities include a review of geocaching basics; the use of a Global Positioning System (GPS); use maps, globes, compasses, program a GPS; and document "finds" and "hiding" geocaches.

## **Power Play Hockey**

Increase your hockey skills through Power Play Hockey! Your child will learn the basics of hockey including how the equipment is used, how to control the puck, different methods of shooting on goal, and the different types of passes. They will also learn positional play, basic rules of the game, sportsmanship, and being a team player. Provide your child with the skills to participate in the fastest growing sport in Nashville!

## **Artist Workshop 101**

Let your child's creative juices flow with an Art Workshop!

Students will be introduced to art materials such as paints and pastels. They will learn processes such as metal tooling, plaster, printmaking, and action painting. Lastly, they will dabble in clay the first day and bring their creation home at the end of the week. Come prepared to create, and get messy! Art clothes are encouraged.

## **Bon Appetit!**

Experience the world without leaving the classroom! In Bon Appetit students will experience foods from around the world besides their cultural practices. Students will learn cooking safety, how to prepare simple recipes, and develop an appreciation of different foods. Students will leave with a cook book and craft to bring home reminiscent of their cultural journey.

## **It's Sand-tastic!**

Sand is a great medium to work with when creating works of art. Your child will learn about all things sand art including the weathering process that creates the sand to how the final pieces are created. There are three main categories: sand structures,

bottle art, and sand paintings. Students will also learn the history of where and when each art form began. Activities include coloring sand, creating sand bottle art and sand sculptures, sand painting, and decorating plastic jars to function as vases.

## **Making Reading App'en**

Throw out the paper and go digital with reading using iPads. In this class students will learn about several reading apps and on-line books. They will learn how to access and navigate digital reading by finding digital sources to find information, and developing a deeper love for reading. They will also create their very own digital book!

## **Dinosaurs**

Bring Jurassic Park to life as students are submerged in the world of dinosaurs! Your child will tap into their creative side and imagination as they learn about different dinosaurs and how they lived. They will learn about a T-rex to a Stegosaurus and everything in between. Students will even raise their own dinosaur egg and create a dinosaur!

# *June 10th - 14th, 2013 (cont.)*

## **Wizards Academy**

Come play in the magical world of Harry Potter in the Wizards Academy! Students will learn magic spells, how to play quidditch, and learn about magical creatures. They may even meet a creature! Lastly, students will learn an appreciation for the environment and animals developed through mythical creatures.

## **A Summer to Remember : Kids Crafts**

Commemorate your child's summer by creating keepsakes. Students will learn how to make several products while creating lasting memories while exploring different materials. Crafts may include a memory box, decorating a clip board, patriotic streamers, a push pin board, and a self-reflection collage.

## **Lights...Camera...Action!**

Become a videographer for the summer with this technical class. Students will be given an introduction to taking videos. Learn the whole process of taking videos from brainstorming ideas for video concepts, shooting videos,

uploading to laptops, and editing them. Students will even publish their videos to a DVD and share with the class at their own Kenrose Film Fest!

## **Paparazzi**

Get a new perspective by looking at life behind a lens. In Paparazzi students will be introduced to taking pictures. Students will learn about framing, lighting, and action shots before taking pictures. Next, your child get behind the lens and take indoor and outdoor pictures, proceeding to editing the pictures with different effects. Lastly, students will publish their pictures and show their slideshows with the class.

## **To Infinity and Beyond: Rocket Building**

Do you like space, building objects, or dabbling in science? Then this class is for you! Learn how to make model rockets from scratch and how the engine works to propel the rocket through the sky. Build, paint, and launch your very own rocket, and the different uses for rockets through history.

## **Game Crazy**

Do you go crazy when someone mentions a game night? Well, you can play games for an entire week with this fun class! Games include Go Fish, Crazy Eights, Uno, and Set. Learn the rules, basic strategies, and how to take turns and be a good sport.

## **Wonders of Wixie**

If math is your idea of a fun summer, than join this digital math class! Learn how to use the basic tools of Wixie and how to apply them to math activities. Explore paint, text boxes, clip art, and voice recording besides completing math activities.

## **Minute to Win It**

This class will teach problem solving skills and encourage your child to think outside the box". Students will enhance their creativity while playing various games and tasks that challenge them to be patient and perform against the clock.

## *You, Me, and the Wii*

Kick your child's exercise routine into gear with You, Me, and the Wii! Students will engage in challenging, but fun exercises through Just Dance videos. It will encourage your child that exercise is good for their heart, mind, and body!

## *The Wonderful World of Legos*

Bring out the builder in your child with this interactive class! Students will create lego projects using technology, written directions, pictures, imagination, and team work. They will even learn to build a Nashvilian building and create a large project as a team.

## *Beading And Beyond*

The students will create beautiful beaded items that they will design and wear. The students will be beading fashionable bracelets, scarves, bags, flip flops and headbands. In designing their creations they will discover the different ways that materials can be used and worn and how sometimes the outcomes of a design can vary. In planning their designs they will utilize different materials and manipulatives. The design of each item and the materials used to create it will be chosen by the student and will reflect their personal style. The students will discuss why and how they choose to create their beautiful design. The students will be able to see the results of their design ideas and their construction efforts all while having fun creating their beaded items. Upon completion of this class the students will have the knowledge to continue to create beautiful beaded items that will reflect their individual image and style.

## *I Heart Art*

Girls, are you ready to start designing your own clothing? Well, this class is for you! Each day you will create a design for an object or clothing for an event. Designs include personality cubes, paper quilled animals, island paradise, wedding party jewelery, and M&M character day.
