Many of you will remember last August when Kenrose hosted Governor Haslam and the State of Tennessee's celebration and announcement of the 2012 Tennessee Reward Schools. I am proud to share that the 2013 list was recently announced, and once more Kenrose has been named a Tennessee Reward School! Kenrose received this award for being in the top 5% in the state for performance on the 2013 TCAP. In 2012, there were 7 Williamson County Schools, including Kenrose, that were named as Reward Schools. This year there are 26! Please join me in congratulating everyone who worked so hard on TCAP to create the success that resulted in this award. We are proud of our Kenrose teachers and students!






