You will also find a letter from the Brentwood Police Department regarding parking on side streets near Kenrose at dismissal time. The Brentwood Police Department has requested that I distribute this letter to Kenrose parents.

For the safety of our children and for efficiency, please review the following procedures for car riders for morning arrival and for afternoon dismissal. We ask for your cooperation by adhering to the following procedures.

Morning Arrival Please do not exceed 15 mph in any area of the school campus!

- 1. Pull up as far as you can in the **RIGHT LANE ONLY**.
- 2. Be sure to keep the driveway clear so that buses pass through to the bus lane/exit the campus.
- 3. Encourage your child/children to have all backpacks and materials ready so that they may exit the car quickly.
- 4. A safety patrol student will be on duty to assist as needed. Students should exit vehicles from the RIGHT SIDE ONLY. Wait for your child to be safely on the sidewalk before moving your car. Please encourage your child to walk close to the building and not along the sidewalk near the moving cars.
- 5. Remain in the right hand lane to slowly exit the drop off line. **DO NOT PASS ON THE LEFT!**
- 6. **Refrain from using your cell phone for any purpose during the arrival process.** This is unsafe for the children as well as the staff members and students who are on duty.
- 7. Do not pull into any parking space and send your child to the crosswalk unattended. On a limited, as needed basis, if you need to walk your child into the school, you should park in a designated space and walk them all the way into the building. Only park in the handicapped space with proper documentation.
- 8. Follow directives of crossing guards and staff members. Watch for children at all times!

Arrival will be quick and efficient if everyone adheres to these procedures. Most importantly, we will be certain that all children arrive safely. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!

Afternoon Dismissal Please do not exceed 15 mph in any area of the school campus!

- 1. Do not instruct your child to dismiss as a "down the hill walker" and load into your car in the neighborhood.
- 2. Pull up as far as you can in one of the three rows that will be formed.
- 3. Do not park in the parking lot and walk across traffic to pick up your child. Do not ask your child to walk into the parking lot to meet you.
- 4. No child will be allowed to go to vehicles beyond the end of the sidewalk near the flagpole. If your car is beyond the sidewalk, stay in your car and wait for the line to move forward.
- 5. Turn your engine **OFF** when students are present and do not restart until you are given the signal to do so.
- 6. Stay in or beside your car. Do not come to the sidewalk to meet your child. We will help your child locate you, if needed.
- 7. All children will receive a signal from a Kenrose staff member when it is time to load in the vehicles. Please do not motion for your child to come to you before this signal is given. Cars you cannot see may still be moving.
- 8. **NEVER LEAVE YOUR CAR UNATTENDED**. If your child is not in your car when it is time to dismiss, please pull around again to keep the cars flowing smoothly.
- 9. Be sure to keep the driveway clear so that buses can pass through to the bus lane.
- 10. After starting your engine, proceed and merge slowly.
- 11. **Refrain from using cell phone for any purpose during the dismissal process.** This is unsafe for the children as well as the staff members who are on duty.
- 12. Follow directives of staff members and crossing guards. Watch for children at all times!

Dismissal will be quick and efficient if everyone adheres to these procedures. Most importantly, we will be certain that all children are dismissed safely. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!

The Brentwood Police Department is committed to reducing danger to children during their release from Kenrose Elementary School. Over the past few years, parents are increasingly parking on public roadways near the school to pick up their children. Both parents and children regularly walk between parked cars to get to their vehicle, or cross the road to walk home. Many of these vehicles are large SUV's and vans with limited visibility that make it difficult to see the children. Residents and delivery vehicles often drive through the area at the time school is dismissed, creating additional risk. The Brentwood Police Department is concerned that there is an imminent risk that someone will be struck by a car and a preventable tragedy will occur.

In response, the Brentwood Police Department strongly encourages parents to use the car rider line overseen by Kenrose Elementary staff. *It is the safest way to pick up your child from school*. The children are released in a controlled environment where the traffic is closely monitored.

The afternoon parking situation has also generated concern over Fire Department and Emergency Medical response. Vehicles' parking on both sides of the roadway narrow the roadway to one lane or less. In an emergency, fire apparatus and ambulances may be forced to alter their route, which increases response times. In some cases they may not be able to reach the emergency at all.

In addition, many area residents have voiced their concerns about child safety. In addition, they have reported children crossing the street without adult supervision and driveways blocked by vehicles, preventing deliveries or other services from entering.

These concerns have prompted the Brentwood Police Department to take preventative steps to protect the public. Several months ago the City of Brentwood posted several "no parking" signs posted on the public roadways around the school. This was done to deter parents from congesting the roads and putting themselves and their children at risk. The Brentwood Police Department has given the public ample notice, and will begin enforcing no parking violations by issuing citations to violators.

The Brentwood Police Department does not want to issue citations. We want a safe environment for the children. To ensure the safety of your children and avoid being issued a citation please use the car rider pick up. It is the safest and most efficient way to pick up your children after school.




