#### From Our Principal...

As our Kenrose PTO begins this year's Build the Nest, I want to say "thank you" to Kenrose parents for all the support that you give to Kenrose teachers and our entire school. Your support is evident in your volunteering, in your presence to support your children at school events, and in all the ways you work.

I want Kenrose parents to know that the bulk of the funding raised by the Kenrose PTO comes directly to the school to support teaching and learning. Careful consideration is given to the ways the funding is spent, and it is very much appreciated by teachers, administrators, and staff! The PTO budget process begins in the spring when teachers and staff are asked to submit and justify items that are needed for the coming year. The PTO executive board puts long hours into considering needs and creating a budget that touches as many students and meets as many needs as possible. PTO events for parents and students, such as the Newcomer's Breakfast, Cardinal Connection, and Back to School Bash are funded by the budget. Large, one-time expense items (such as the library mural, the kiln for art, and the piano for music) are funded by the budget. Ongoing expenses, such as funding making it possible for Kenrose to have a computer lab teacher assistant and a school chorus director, replacing worn-out classroom rugs, replenishing mulch on the K-2 playground, and supporting our technology initiative are included in the budget. And, we are fortunate that a large portion of the budget goes directly to teachers to provide for needs in their classrooms. All teachers receive funds from Build the Nest that help meet their classroom needs. Teachers new to Kenrose and teachers changing grade levels receive extra funding to help set up classrooms. All purchases are made utilizing our school's purchase order (p.o.) process. I personally review and approve each p.o., and I can assure parents that our teachers, administrators, and staff are good stewards of Build the Nest funds.

I hope that you will take the opportunity to ask Kenrose teachers about the difference that PTO funding makes in their classrooms. I will mention one of the PTO initiatives that is most used by our teachers and students, our instructional technology initiative. Thanks primarily to the efforts of our PTO, during the past five years all Kenrose classrooms have been equipped with SMART Boards, LCD projectors, and (Elmo) document cameras. We have purchased three laptop carts that teachers can borrow. We have three sets of eClicks that teachers use for electronic response systems; we would like to have six sets, one set per grade level. And, all of our teachers have iPads for instructional use with students. Because our teachers use instructional technology very effectively, I hope to see our PTO continue to support our technology initiative.

If you have any questions about how PTO funding at Kenrose is used, please feel free to ask a teacher, ask me, or ask any member of the PTO executive board. Once again, thank you for all you do to support teaching and learning at Kenrose, including Build the Nest!

If your child completed the 2013 Summer Forget Me Not activities for his or her grade level, please send the signed form to your child's homeroom teacher this week. Thank you!
