## Poster Contest

**Eligibility:** Limited to 3rd grade students.

**Theme:** I Saw a Tree Today

**Poster Size:** 11"x17"

Students may pick up a poster from Mrs. Nix once they have a vision in mind and have practiced their idea. One poster per student.

**Art Medium:** Students' choice of materials (ex. natural materials, crayons, markers, photos, pictures, letters, cloth, pen and ink, oils, pastels, watercolors, etc.). Artwork is not to be raised from poster surface more than ½ inches.  
\*The front of each poster entry must also display the student's first and last name, school name, and grade.

**Cash Prizes:** \$65 for 1<sup>st</sup> place, \$40 for 2<sup>nd</sup> place and \$20 for 3<sup>rd</sup> place, chosen from all of the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade participants.

**Submission Deadline:** Thursday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2016!

Posters should be turned in to Mrs. Nix in the Art room (#305). From there, posters will be submitted for judging on March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

Winning entries from each school will be on display at the Brentwood Library from March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2016 through the Arbor Day celebration on Saturday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2016. Prizes will be awarded during the Brentwood Library's Arbor Day ceremony, 11:30 am located at 8109 Concord Road.
